

BOC Athlete Code of Conduct

1. Respect and listen to your coaches.
2. Be courteous and respectful to mountain employees, ski patrol, and all other skiers. You are a representative of the Bromley Outing Club and will be held to a high standard. Your behavior reflects on all club members.
3. Be on time for all activities.
4. Clean up after yourself in the lodges and at the Clubhouse. Leave it cleaner than when you arrived.
5. Leave other athletes' and coaches' equipment alone, WITHOUT EXCEPTION.
6. All equipment left in the Clubhouse must be neatly stored in its proper place.
7. Offices and coaches' rooms are off limits, except by invitation.
8. If you lose your coach/group, go to the BOC clubhouse and your coach will be contacted.
9. Specific Rules:
 - a. Behave in a sportsman-like manner during training, competition, and events organized by the BOC whether at Bromley or elsewhere.
 - b. Respect fellow competitors - no put-downs.
 - c. No line cutting or barging.
 - d. Listen when a coach is talking.
 - e. Never say "I can't".
 - f. NO snowballs, swearing or fighting.
10. Skier Safety Code:
 - a. Ski/ride under control and in such a manner that you can stop or avoid other skiers or objects.
 - b. When skiing/riding downhill or overtaking another skier/rider, avoid the person below you. Down hill persons have the right of way.
 - c. Do not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
 - d. When entering a trail or starting downhill, yield to other skiers/riders.
 - e. All skiers/riders shall use devices to prevent runaway skis/boards.
 - f. Keep off closed trails and/or posted areas and observe all signs.

Disciplinary Action

In the event that an athlete violates the Code of Conduct, one or more of the following may occur:

1. Discussion with parents, coaches and athlete concerned.
2. Suspension of skiing/riding privileges.
3. Suspension of competition privileges.
4. Suspension from Competition Program - no refund.
